Pediatrics Expands to Family Practice

What: Fourth Street Clinic's Pediatric Program is now a full-service Family Practice Clinic that is available to **kids of all ages who are experiencing homelessness, their parents and former pediatric patients who are now older than 22 years of age.** The Family Practice Medical Team is Dr. Tanya Williams and Jeff Daniels, RN. Both have years of experience, and Dr. Williams speaks Spanish. The clinic operates at Fourth Street Clinic in a separate area with a family-friendly waiting and exams rooms.

Services: Services are the same as with the Pediatric Program, but expanded to the adults listed above.

- Care for injuries, flus, colds, diabetes, asthma, etc.
- Vaccinations
- Well child exams
- Birth control including IUDs
- Women's health exams
- Eye exams
- Laboratory testing and radiology
- Pharmacy
- Referrals to specialty care services
- Eligibility screening and case management for public insurance, financial assistance, housing and other social programs
